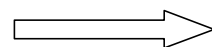

Children will be encouraged to display and share their confirmation projects in Fr. Feeney Hall during the spring retreat.

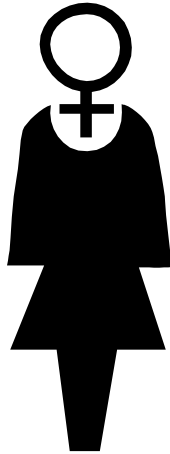
Please make sure and return the Confirmation Project 2011 Form with the other required paperwork by the deadline.
